Disease


Lions are now being targeted to meet the demands of the illegal wildlife trade market, e.g. the Asian medicinal market.



Getting Started

Grow a beard



Did you know that lions in the wild are facing extinction?

In the 1960's there were over 200,000 lions - today we estimate there to be barely 15,000 across the whole of the vast, African continent. Unless we can halt this catastrophic decline, lions could be extinct within only TEN years.

As the leading conservation charity dedicated to preserving Africa's lion populations for future generations, LionAid depends entirely on donor support to continue our vital work.

Here are some of the actions we are taking right now to save African Lions:

Working to achieve a ban on the importation of lion trophies into Europe and to influence Governments around the world to do the same.

Highlighting the horrors of the canned lion hunting industry and its associated cub petting trade, volunteer market and lion walking business

Working with Governments to stop the illegal wildlife trade. The trade in lion bones is accelerating and is inevitably leading to an escalation of lion poaching in poverty stricken rural areas of Africa.

Highlighting the cub smuggling trade which feeds the canned lion hunting industry and the pet trade, particularly to the United Arab Emirates.

Discouraging zoos worldwide from keeping and breeding lions (to supply a stream of cute cubs to boost visitor numbers) and to particularly desist from breeding white lions which have no conservation value.


